Most Mexican consignees have a Mexican freight forwarder set up at the land crossing entering Mexico (ex. Laredo, TX.) The consignee is responsible for a 15% import duty that must be paid before the product enters Mexico.

Will the product clear or go in bond in the US?
The shipper usually has a US customs agent at the land border going into the US. Most shipments go in bond so the shipper does not need to pay US duties. Country Transport has a US Customs agent capable to put loads in bond for a nominal fee.
